HE IS PRESENTLY UNDERGOING TREATMENT UNDER DR MILO A MOCHAL OF THE STARKOW CLINIC, THIEF RIVER FALLS, MINN. PERIODICALLY FOR A DIABATIC CONDITION.

Dear Comrade Miramontes:


As shown by the transmittal from we have submitted the forms you sent us concerning the above named veteran.
